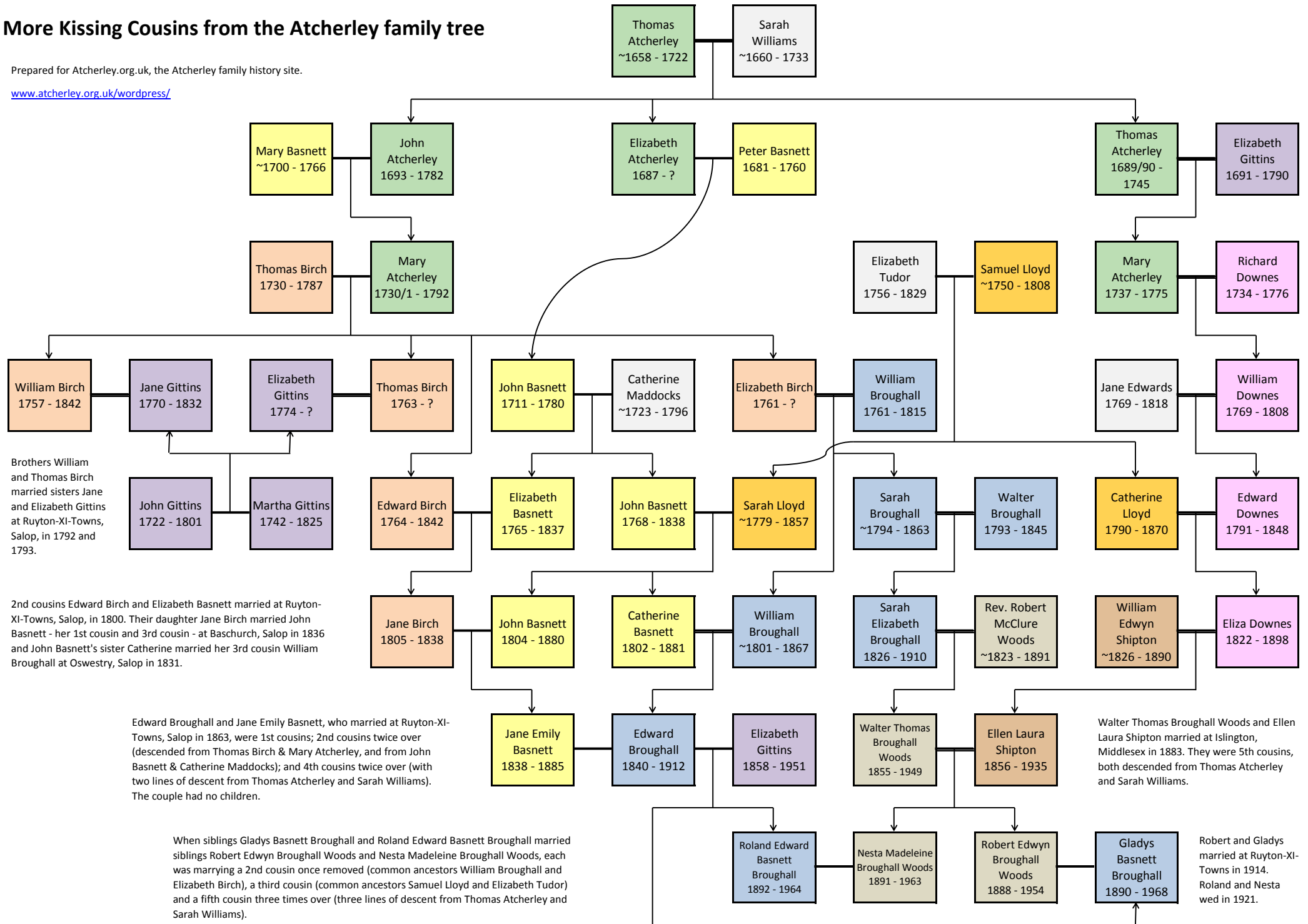


# More Kissing Cousins from the Atcherley family tree

Brothers William and Thomas Birch married sisters Jane and Elizabeth Gittins at Ruyton-XI-Towns, Salop, in 1792 and 1793.

2nd cousins Edward Birch and Elizabeth Basnett married at Ruyton-XI-Towns, Salop, in 1800. Their daughter Jane Birch married John Basnett - her 1st cousin and 3rd cousin - at Baschurch, Salop in 1836 and John Basnett's sister Catherine married her 3rd cousin William Broughall at Oswestry, Salop in 1831.

Edward Broughall and Jane Emily Basnett, who married at Ruyton-XI-Towns, Salop in 1863, were 1st cousins; 2nd cousins twice over (descended from Thomas Birch & Mary Atcherley, and from John Basnett & Catherine Maddocks); and 4th cousins twice over (with two lines of descent from Thomas Atcherley and Sarah Williams). The couple had no children.

When siblings Gladys Basnett Broughall and Roland Edward Basnett Broughall married siblings Robert Edwyn Broughall Woods and Nesta Madeleine Broughall Woods, each was marrying a 2nd cousin once removed (common ancestors William Broughall and Elizabeth Birch), a third cousin (common ancestors Samuel Lloyd and Elizabeth Tudor) and a fifth cousin three times over (three lines of descent from Thomas Atcherley and Sarah Williams).

Walter Thomas Broughall Woods and Ellen Laura Shipton married at Islington, Middlesex in 1883. They were 5th cousins, both descended from Thomas Atcherley and Sarah Williams.

Robert and Gladys married at Ruyton-XI-Towns in 1914. Roland and Nesta wed in 1921.
